The International Academy of Sports Sciences & Technology (AISTS) in Lausanne is in charge of organizing the postgraduate course in Sport Administration & Technology (MSA). EPFL is in charge of admitting, billing and administering MSA students in the name and for the account of AISTS.

## 2. Documents for matriculation to bring with you

**!!!VERY IMPORTANT!!!**

You will be matriculated at the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology (EPFL). **In the first week of the MSA you will have to go to the EPFL Admissions office (called "Service Académique"), located on the first floor of the "Bâtiment Polyvalent", to collect your student identification card and the official registration document called "Attestation", which will be necessary to obtain the student permit of residence.**

If you have not sent the **original university degree or a certified copy** (original certification from the university – NOT photocopies) you will have to show it at this moment. This is VERY important, if you don't have them you won't be able to matriculate!!!

## 3. Immigration and travel

### Passport:

Make sure you have a valid passport or identification card.

### Student Visa:

Students coming from outside EU-EEA-countries need to acquire a visa. It must be applied for before departure to Switzerland at the closest Swiss Embassy with the letter of admission from EPFL. You should ask for a visa called "B permit". A "tourist visa" cannot be changed into a student permit once you have arrived in Switzerland.

## 4. Health insurance

According to the Swiss law, all students must be insured against sickness and accidents. The EPFL has a contract with a company but students are free to choose another company. The EPFL social service (contact: Mrs Eliane Reuille, phone: + 41 (0)21 693 22 80; E-mail: [eliane.reuille@epfl.ch](mailto:eliane.reuille@epfl.ch)) is at your disposal to give you the necessary information on the conditions offered by the company. You are free to choose the insurer you wish, and to do so, you should compare the premiums and benefits of several companies (good website for this: [www.comparis.ch](http://www.comparis.ch)). In Switzerland, there is a basic minimum health insurance package that is offered by all the companies and mandatory for everyone; packages of extended benefits ("assurance complémentaire"), on the other hand, are optional.

Average cost per month: CHF 150-300.

Students from the EU-EEA countries have to get the European form E128 duly signed from their foreign insurance company. As soon as they arrive in Switzerland, they have to send this form to the Central Office in Solothurn : Institution Commune LAMAL, KVG, Gibelinstrasse 25, CH-4502 Solothurn : <http://www.kvg.org> or [info@kvg.org](mailto:info@kvg.org)

Most of the students remain affiliated to their own insurance company.

Students coming from outside EU-EEA countries may remain affiliated to their own insurance company provided that they ask permission from the "Organe Cantonal de Contrôle" : <http://www.occ.ch> , e-mail : [info@occ.ch](mailto:info@occ.ch)

A written statement from the foreign company giving full details on the extent and the amount of the cover must be joined to the request.

To benefit from exemption, two conditions are to be fulfilled :

1. affiliation to a sickness insurance is compulsory in the home-country of the student
2. the cover guaranteed by the insurance should be as the one requested by the Swiss law.

The premium to pay will be based on the place of residence, on the age and on the deductible chosen by the student. Its price ranges from Fr. 150.- to Fr. 225.- per month.

The level of health care in Switzerland is high and expensive. If you get ill and need urgent medical attention, contact the nearest health-care centre called "Permanence médicale" or the CHUV (University Hospital Centre for the Canton of Vaud), phone: 021 314 11 11. You can go there without any appointment. The emergency number (for ambulances etc.) in Switzerland is 144.

For dental emergencies you may go to the "Permanence dentaire" or to a dental clinic. Dental costs are not covered by the health insurance and are very expensive.

Medicines prescribed by a doctor can be bought at any pharmacy. Pharmacies are open from 8:30 m to 6:30 pm on workdays. Outside these hours, most pharmacies display a notice on the door mentioning the address of the nearest open pharmacy. All the costs must be paid but your health insurance will partially reimburse you later.

## 5. Travel

**Train Geneva airport – Lausanne:** The international airport of Geneva is situated 60 km from Lausanne. There are 3 direct trains to Lausanne per hour. Duration: 45 minutes. Price: CHF 23.- (one way). The railway station is situated just under the airport. Ask for directions once you have landed.

## 6. Working

Foreign students are not allowed to work during the six first months of their stay in Switzerland. After this period, they can work 15 hours/week during the semesters and full time during the academic holidays. Students have to get an attestation from the EPFL "Social service" confirming that the job is compatible with the studies.

## 7. How much will it cost to study and live in Lausanne?

**Living expenses in Lausanne** - Average monthly budget:

Food and personal care:	CHF 750 - 850
Housing: + utilities	CHF 400 - 650
Health and accident insurance:	CHF 150 - 300

**Total: CHF 1300-1800 per month**

### **IMPORTANT:**

At the beginning of your stay, several expenses will need to be taken care of all at once, notably:

- a quarterly health insurance premium
- your first month's rent plus a rental deposit
- the payment of your residence permit to the Foreign Residents' Office and your local town authorities

## 8. Living in Lausanne

### **Lausanne:**

Lausanne has a population of 125,000 (or 250,000 if we take into account the greater-Lausanne area).

The city offers many opportunities for studies, business, shopping, medical care and sport. Over 20'000 students live in Lausanne, this gives the city a young and lively atmosphere.

### **Public transportation in Lausanne:**

Tickets have to be bought before getting on the bus or the metro.

All bus lines, except for line 3, go through the city centre of Lausanne (Place St. François). The network covers Lausanne and the nearby suburbs.

**Train: Swiss Federal Rail (CFF):**

We highly recommend that you buy a half-fare season ticket ("abonnement demi-tarif"), which allows you to purchase all Swiss train tickets in Switzerland at half the price.

Cost for one year: CHF 150.-

If you are under 25 and are going to use the Swiss Federal train after 7 pm you should buy the "Voie 7" a train pass that allows you to travel for free after 7 pm. It costs CHF 99 per year if you are the holder of a half-price season ticket.

**Parking at EPFL:**

If you want to use your own car to go to the EPFL, you will have to buy a parking card at the Information Desk on the Esplanade. The card costs CHF 75.- per semester. You will be asked to show your student card and the identification card of your car.

**Shops:**

Most shops are normally open between 08:30 am and 18:30, except on Saturdays when most stores close at 5pm. All shops are closed all day on Sunday. Many larger stores and Supermarkets have at least one late-night opening until 8pm or 9 pm.

A small grocery store called "Le Négoce" is located on the EPFL 5 minutes from the MSA classroom.

**Food:**

There are several restaurants and cafeterias at the EPFL. They offer hot meals, coffee and snacks. The price for a complete meal for students is CHF 6.50 – CHF 8.50.

Be aware that food products are more expensive in Switzerland than in most other countries of Europe!

## 9. Students arriving in Lausanne – Residence Permit

At their arrival foreign students must present themselves personally at the 'service du contrôle des habitants' in order to register themselves and adapt their status to Switzerland.

The students must go to their place of residence office of 'service du contrôle des habitants' with the following documents: Only then will the student be granted their permit.

- <b>passport</b>	with student visa if required
- <b>report/arriving announcement</b>	from school
- <b>school attestation</b>	congruent with 'art. 32 de l'ordonnance fédérale du 6 octobre 1986'
- <b>2 photos</b>	passport size, recent
- <b>bank attestation</b>	Must have an amount sufficient to cover the cost of the studies stated on the school attestation
<b>or</b>	
- <b>grant or loan attestation</b>	Swiss or foreign. The amount must be clearly stated
<b>or</b>	
- <b>parents garantie</b>	Forms are available at the office or click on the following link (en cliquant ici). Must be completed by the mother or the father, certified by the local authorities and with a permanent bank transfer
<b>or</b>	
- <b>guarantee from a third party</b>	Forms are available at the office or click on following link (en cliquant ici). The warrantor must live in Switzerland and prove to have sufficient financial means to help the student. His signature must be certified by the local authorities.

## 10. Student Accommodation in Lausanne

**It is very difficult to find a place to stay in Lausanne!**

Please get on it now and before you get to Switzerland!

### I. Before you come to Switzerland

**A.** The best solution is to book a room in the student halls. You should put your names down immediately by telephone or directly on-line:

**B.** If you would like an apartment or studio you will need to come to Switzerland well before the course starts and it is then up to you to make the first contact. Please be aware that people from abroad who try to rent a flat will face the difficulty of finding a guarantor who already lives in Switzerland. Under the Swiss law, the guarantor must sign a lease for an apartment, this person must have a permanent resident permit for Switzerland. It is not possible with a student visa.

Note : There are some agencies who are sometimes willing to accept international students without the need for a guarantor. You must ask the agency when you call.

**Leases & Damage Deposits:** Almost all apartments in Switzerland will ask for a damage deposit of 3 months rent in advance and will require a minimum 1 year lease. With regards to the lease, you can generally leave at any time as long as you give 3 months notice (double check with the agency). Alternatively, you can leave at any time as long as you can find people willing to rent the apartment (as long as the agency approves them). As housing is very competitive in Lausanne, it is not difficult to find people who are willing to rent on short notice.

**Apartments:** Most apartments in Switzerland are rented through real estate agencies. You can either contact the agencies directly or visit websites like [www.immostreet.ch/stutz](http://www.immostreet.ch/stutz) and [www.zannonces.ch](http://www.zannonces.ch) that collate the list of apartments. Good apartments are rented very quickly (1-3 days) in Lausanne so the best thing to do is ask each agency to email or fax the daily apartment list and then try to go see the room as soon as possible. A list of the major real estate agencies (agence immobiliers or gérances in French) located in Lausanne can be found on page 11 (liste des gérances de Lausanne).

## II. Once you are in Switzerland and have started the course

The accommodation office of the University has a comprehensive list of rooms in private houses or flats, rooms in flats shared with other students, or independent rooms with their own separate entrance, all located near the University. **You will have access to their service once you get here and you are matriculated at the EPFL.**

You can consult the lists of available apartments, or rooms via **Intranet** on the EPFL Website: you will need your password and "camipro" number in order to access the names and addresses of landlords. If you would like to contact the accommodation office please do so on: [logement@unil.ch](mailto:logement@unil.ch) and give them your family name, first name, country, the date on which you begin your studies, the name of your future faculty or section, and your matriculation number. They will then send you a PDF format list of available lodgings.

Remember to indicate what type of accommodation you prefer. Choose from the following list:

Independent flat

Studio

Shared flat (with other students)

Room (in a private house or flat)

Independent room (with separate entrance)

### Flats

Almost all available flats are managed by house-letting agents, so you should start your search by contacting them. We must draw your attention to the fact that you may be asked to deposit up to 3 months rent in advance as a guarantee. Flats cannot be rented for 6 months or less; letting leases are usually for a minimum of one year. People from abroad who try to rent a flat will face the difficulty of finding a guarantor who already lives in Switzerland. Under the Swiss law, in order to sign a lease for an apartment the person must have a permanent residents permit for Switzerland. It is not possible with a student visa.

### Rooms

These are study-bedrooms, usually furnished, in a privately owned house or flat. The house-holder may ask for 1 or 2 months rent in advance as a guarantee. On average rooms cost CHF 450.- to 600.- maximum per month.

### Independent rooms

These are study-bedrooms, usually furnished, in a privately owned house or flat, but with their own separate entrance. The house-holder may ask for 1 or 2 months rent in advance as a guarantee.

## III: Insurance (civil liability, house, fire insurance)

You are advised to take out a civil liability insurance (RC), as well as a house insurance which will cover damage caused by water, theft due to breaking and entering, or broken windows. Insurance premiums are reasonable. Contact an insurance company for more details on premiums and policies.

**Important information:** Please note that a house insurance policy applies to a flat rented in your own name. Tenants who are sub-letting are not always covered by the same insurance laws.

**Fire insurance is compulsory in the canton of Vaud. (ECA)** You will receive a letter by mail that you will need to return. Please see example on following page.

## 11. Money matters

### Currency:

The Swiss currency unit is the Swiss Franc (which is shorted to CHF, Sfr. or Fr.). A Franc is worth 100 cents ("centimes").

1 CHF = about 0,6 Euro = about 0,6 USD

### Banks:

For foreigners it may be necessary to open a bank account. All banks offer approximately the same kind of services. There is a bank on the EPFL campus. The Swiss Post also offers banking services.

To apply for a bank account, you need your passport and your residence permit.

## 12. MSA Classroom and Computer Room

### MSA Classroom:

The MSA classroom is located in the centre of the EPFL campus, next to all the school facilities – restaurants, post office, bank office, grocery store, travel agency, etc.

## 13. Internships

An internship within a sport-related administration, project or company is required for obtaining the Master's Degree. Consequently, you are kindly asked to begin looking for an internship as soon as possible. You can do it also in your home country before the beginning of the MSA.

The internships guidelines will be downloadable from the web site. A final report describing your internship is also required and will be reviewed by the MSA steering committee.

## 14. Others

### E-mail account:

All MSA students will get a personal e-mail address (name.surname@epfl.ch). The user-name and password will be given to you a few days after your arrival.

### Photocopy card:

Cards can be purchased at the information desk, on the Esplanade or at the Boutique Agepoly.

### Post offices:

Post offices are opened from 7:30 am to 6 pm from Monday to Friday and from 8 am to 11 am on Saturdays. In addition to the ordinary mailing service, the Post Company also offers a banking service, a telephone and fax service. A post office is located on the EPFL campus, not far from the MSA classroom.

### Telephone:

If you already have a GSM mobile phone you can buy a pre-paid card with a Swiss telephone number.

If you don't want to buy a mobile phone, there are public payphones on the campus and in the city. Phone cards of CHF 10, 20 or 50 can be bought at any news stand.

If you want to dial a phone number in Switzerland from abroad, dial:

1. The international admission number
2. The country code for Switzerland: 41
3. the subscriber's phone number which has 9 figures (take away the first "0" that you would dial if you are in Switzerland)

If you want to dial a home number abroad from Switzerland, dial:

1. The international admission number: 00
2. The country code
3. The area code
4. The subscriber's number.

### **Electricity**

The standard voltage is 220 V. Three-pin plugs are standard on most electrical equipments.

### **Sports:**

The University Sports Centre is open for University and EPFL students. It is located by the lake in a beautiful area, 15 minutes (by walk) from the EPFL and it's probably the most beautiful and best equipped university sports centre in Switzerland. More than 50 different activities, ranging from aerobics to yoga are scheduled and most of them are free of charge.
